One-Day Workshop on "Economics of Today, Economists for Tomorrow" 6th October 2023



The workshop titled "Economics of Today, Economists for Tomorrow," held on 6th October 2023, was a Collaboration between the Department of Economics, St Edmund's College, Shillong and Azim Premji University, Bangalore. The Event took place at St Edmund's College Auditorium from 9:30 am to 4:30 pm.

The Workshop was hosted by Ms. Kashyapi Bezbaruah (5th Semester), Invoked by Ms. Nukshijunla Kichu (5th Semester) and the discussions were moderated by Prof. Lorraine Claudia Massar (Assistant Professor, Dept of Economics). The convenor for the workshop was Ms. Labet Phylla Phanbuh, Assistant Professor, Dept of Economics.

The Welcome Address was delivered by the Vice principal (Admin) Prof. Monotosh Chakravarty, highlighting the Department's Contribution to college growth, and discussing the impact of Economics and Education in India. A warm welcome was extended to the participating Colleges St. Anthony's College, St. Mary's College, Shillong Commerce College, Shillong College, Seng Khasi College, Synod College, Women's College, and Lady Keane College. Gratitude was expressed for the presence of the Faculty Members of Azim Premji University Dr. K.C. Adaina, Dr. Zico Dasgupta and Dr. Kedar Kulkarni.

After the welcome Song by the Economics Honours Students of St Edmund's College, the opening remarks was then delivered by Prof. Rajesh Dutta, who discussed climate change and its economic implications, emphasizing the need for social and political consciousness among Economists.

The workshop was divided into five insightful sessions:

<u>Session 1</u>: The Psychological Lives of the Poor – Implications for understanding Poverty in Northeast India: Dr. K.C. Adaina, Faculty, Azim Premji University, discussed poverty, scarcity, and decision-making in North-eastern states, highlighting the impact of scarcity on mental bandwidth and cognitive resources.

<u>Session 2</u>: Macroeconomics in our Daily Lives: Dr. Zico Dasgupta, Faculty, Azim Premji University delved into economic growth, inflation, and macroeconomic policies in India.

<u>Session 3</u>: Emerging Areas in Economics: Dr. Anika M.W. Kshiar Shadap, Faculty, Dept. of Economics, St. Edmund's College, discussed the intersection of nature, knowledge, and economics, referencing the works of Nobel Laureates in Economics.

<u>Session 4</u>: Economics of Climate Change – Trans Himalayan Perspectives: Dr. Kedar Kulkarni, Faculty, Azim Premji University, discussed trade-offs between economic growth and environmental quality, exploring sustainability and climate change Economics.

<u>Session 5</u>: **MA Economics Programme in India – Direction and Recent Trends:** The Azim Premji University Economics Group discussed the pluralist approach in economics education, focusing on the importance of practical skills like statistical software proficiency and fieldwork experience. Various career options for economics graduates in India were discussed, emphasizing the demand for strong communication and critical thinking skills.

The workshop concluded with the Felicitation of Resource Persons, followed by a vote of thanks by Prof. Labet Phylla Phanbuh.

In summary, the workshop provided a comprehensive overview of diverse economic topics, ranging from the psychological aspects of poverty to macroeconomics, climate change, and emerging areas in the field. Participants gained valuable insights into real-world applications of economic theories and the importance of research-based policy making.





A. Total Student Attendees & Student Feedback:




- A significant highlight is that 16 faculty members were also present at the Workshop.
- Of these 16, only one (1) faculty member filled out the feedback form, leading to their exclusion from the charts.


B. Semester Wise Break-Up of Student Attendees & Student Feedback:




C. Break-up of male & female student participants:




D. The themes shared by the Resource Persons has helped the students in a better understanding of the path they would take in the future:




E. The workshop introduced the participants to highly engaging sub-fields and emerging areas in the field of Economics?




F. Do you feel better informed about the expanding horizon and direction of MA Economics programmes across India?



G. Students who are motivated are to pursue MA Economics after Graduation.




H. Would you consider attending and supporting similar workshops/conferences/lecture series/data software training etc. in the future?




I. Which specific sub-fields and emerging areas in Economics captured your attention the most?
