

17th November 2020: 4 pm


- The theme of the Third webinar was "M.B.A. as a career Choice: Preparation to getting into the IIMs"

- Certificates were provided to all participants







Cleared my doubts regarding preparation, CAT exam, which institution to apply for in the future and has encouraged me to really look forward into MBA as a career choice
